A Glimpse of Spirituality 靈修一瞥 154 (Matt 瑪 12:46-50)

Fr. Abraham Chiu 趙必成神父

誰能成為耶穌的母親、兄弟和姊妹？不難理解，我們都是耶穌的兄弟姊妹；可是如何成為他的母親？從神修角度來看，每當向世界傳播天主聖言時，好像耶穌母親將耶穌誕生人間。如耶穌說：“不拘誰遵行我在天之父的旨意，他就是我的兄弟、姊妹和母親。”什麼是天父旨意？“旨意”（*thelēma*）解作耶穌所指屬神關係的基礎；它不該是外在的，而是內在的團體共融；這也是洗禮所指向的，遵行天主旨意就是在生活中實踐聖潔。聖潔本質是愛，將基督徒轉化為耶穌心中摯愛，結果他們成為耶穌的母親、姊妹和兄弟。

當耶穌詳細說明誰是他的兄弟、姊妹和母親時，他向屋內門徒伸出他手；“伸出”（*ekteinas*）這個手勢有很多含義，例如需要幫助、敵意或關注；這裡意即耶穌對他們的保護。簡言之，耶穌強調建立新的精神關係，即天父真正的家庭，同時也是在耶穌保護下的教會。

總之，天父旨意的內容以愛為中心，即教會成員彼此之間作為兄弟、姊妹和母親的關係。身為耶穌門徒，他們必須和耶穌在一起，好能獲得他的保護；此外，他們也需要服從天父旨意，即愛。耶穌希望每個基督徒，都向無限無限的開放

**Christmas: Let Christ be Your Answer to Restlessness**

Christmas is nearly upon us, and as we journey these last few days of Advent, we may feel the pressure of a fast-paced time of last-minute shopping, and visiting our friends and relatives. Perhaps we feel we haven't had much time to intensify our prayer and reflection on the coming of Christ. Strangely, the quote that comes to my mind is that of Saint Augustine:

**“You have made us for yourself, O Lord, and our hearts are restless until they rest in You.”** Restlessness stems from our desire to find fulness or fulfillment. We've all experienced seeking after the next thing that pleases us; the new gadget or toy, or new relationship. But after a while we again feel the need to seek. As we prepare for Christmas, **let our restlessness be a seeking for God.** Come to the manger and be refreshed in the sight of the Son of God—the Word Made Flesh. He has come into the world to take away our sin, and give us rest and peace. Come, let us go with the Shepherds to the manger and rest our hearts in Him.

### Focus of the Gospel:

The Sunday after Christmas focuses on the holiness of family life. By "holiness" we mean that the family truly reflects and participates in the creative activity of God. In the second reading, Paul gives us the Christian principles that both animate and characterize the family life of baptized Christians. We are to help each other grow by being kind, forgiving, gentle, honest, peacemaking, and most of all by our love for each other.

The Gospel tells us that Jesus returned to Nazareth, obeyed Mary and Joseph, and continued to grow in body and wisdom. The point of the Incarnation is that Jesus was truly, fully human. His human development is dependent, as it is for all of us, on the nurturing of a family. That Mary and Joseph provided a nurturing environment is shown by their raising Jesus in their faith tradition and showing concern for his wellbeing. In this way, the Holy Family shows us the way to have holy families.

En la segunda lectura, Pablo nos presenta los principios cristianos que animan y caracterizan la vida familiar de los cristianos bautizados. Debemos ayudarnos mutuamente a crecer mediante la bondad, el perdón, la amabilidad, la honestidad, la paz y, sobre todo, el amor mutuo.

El Evangelio nos dice que Jesús volvió a Nazaret, obedeció a María y a José, y siguió creciendo en cuerpo y sabiduría. El sentido de la Encarnación es que Jesús era verdadera y plenamente humano. Su desarrollo humano depende, como el de todos nosotros, del cuidado de una familia. El hecho de que María y José proporcionaran un entorno propicio queda demostrado por el hecho de que educaran a Jesús en su tradición de fe y mostraran preocupación por su bienestar. De este modo, la Sagrada Familia nos muestra el camino para tener familias santas.

Hermanos: Al entrar al mundo, Cristo dijo, conforme al salmo: No quisiste víctimas ni ofrendas; en cambio, me has dado un cuerpo. No te agradaron los holocaustos ni los sacrificios por el pecado; entonces dije –porque a mí se refiere la Escritura–: “Aquí estoy, Dios mío; vengo para hacer tu voluntad”.

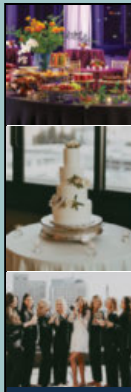
