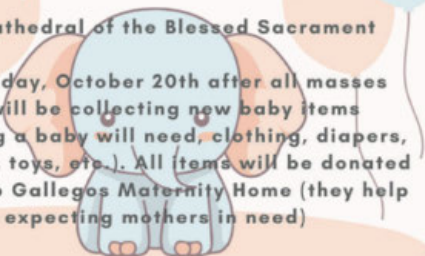
Baby Shower

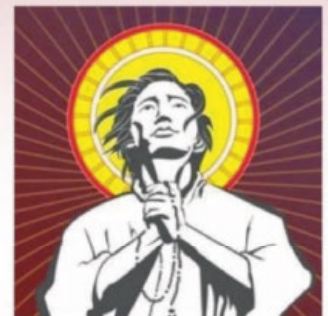

YOU MAY HAVE A SEXUAL ABUSE CLAIM OR OTHER CLAIM AGAINST THE DIOCESE OF SACRAMENTO

On April 1, 2024, The Roman Catholic Bishop of Sacramento aka Diocese of Sacramento filed a chapter 11 bankruptcy petition for protection under title 11 of the United States Code.

If you were sexually abused by any person connected with the Diocese, you must file a claim so as to be received by October 1, 2024, or otherwise you will be forever barred, estopped, and enjoined from asserting such claim against the Diocese.

Claims based on acts or omissions of the Diocese that occurred before April 1, 2024, must be filed on or before October 1, 2024, even if such claims are not now fixed, liquidated, or certain or did not mature or become fixed, liquidated, or certain before April 1, 2024.

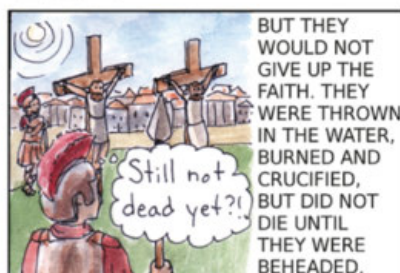
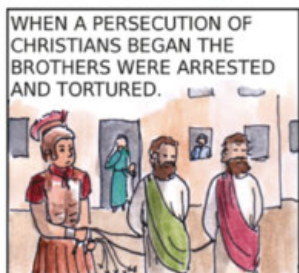

Focus of the Gospel:

Our readings next Sunday focus on the freedom of the Spirit to blow when and where it will. The spirit of God is not, and cannot be, limited to officially appointed positions. In both readings, we find the complain that others outside the group are exercising ministry reserved for those officially appointed: prophecy, casting out evil spirits. This attempt to limit and guard spiritual power is corrected by both Moses and Jesus. God's spirit, and therefore the various ministries for good works, are open to all. Any attempt to limit these ministries to officially designated people is an attempt to limit the freedom of the Spirit of God.

- ♦ Read Mark 9:38-48
- ♦ What did Moses and Jesus say about other people prophesying and curing people of evil spirits?
- ♦ Jesus did not want to exclude anyone. Who are people you know who are left out? Why are they left out?
- ♦ Jesus says God can use anyone to do good. How can God use you for good?
- ♦ Pray Psalm 19:8-14 together.

The wicked say:

But they did not understand the saying, and they were afraid to question him.

They came to Capernaum and, once inside the house, he began to ask them, "What were you arguing about on the way?" But they remained silent. They had been discussing among themselves on the way who was the greatest. Then he sat down, called the Twelve, and said to them, "If anyone wishes to be first, he shall be the last of all and the servant of all." Taking a child, he placed it in their midst, and putting his arms around it, he said to them, "Whoever receives one child such as this in my name, receives me; and whoever receives me, receives not me but the One who sent me."

LECTURA I SAB 2, 12. 17-20

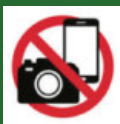

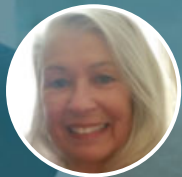
