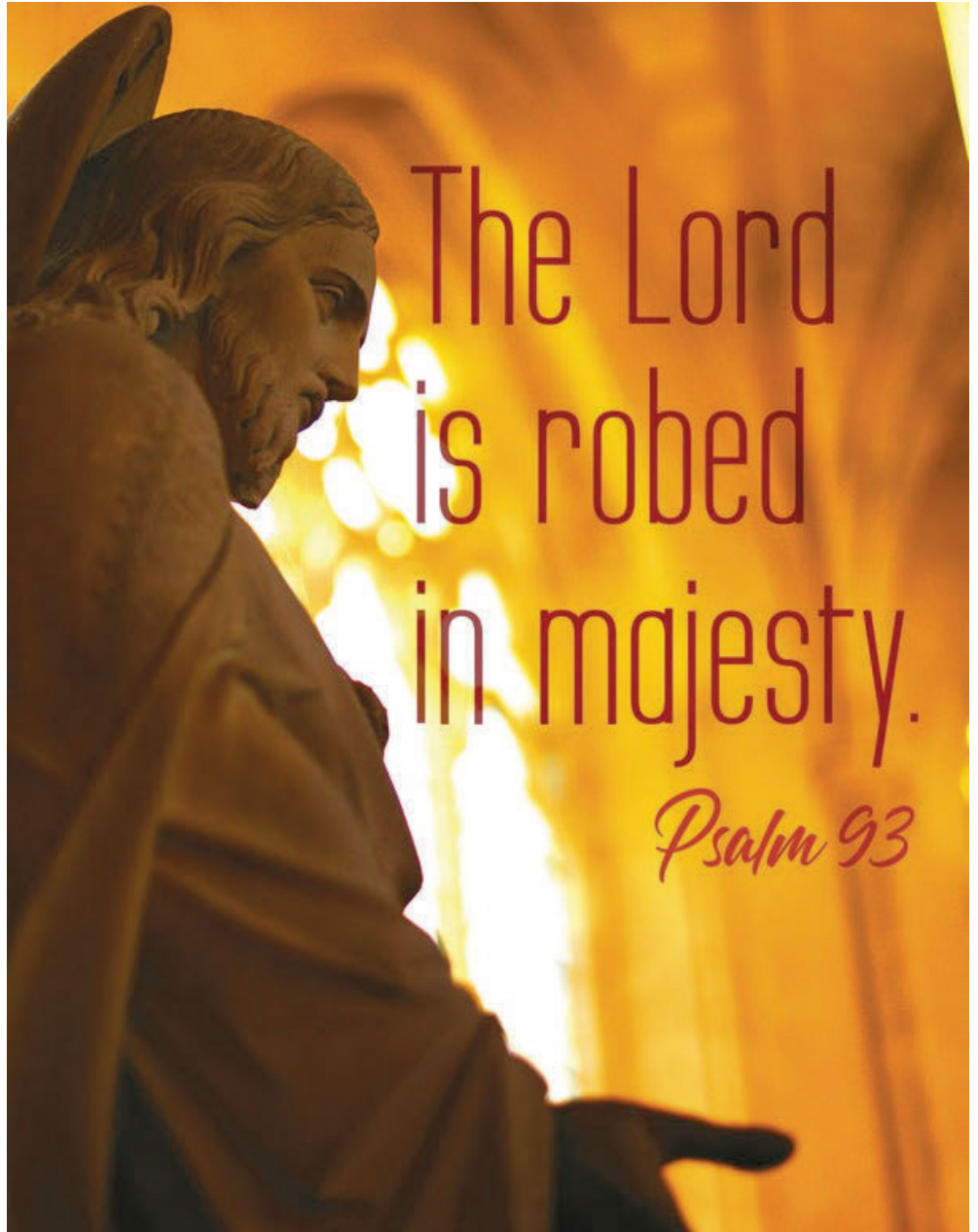

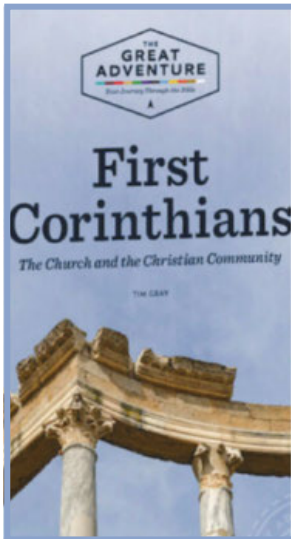

A Glimpse of Spirituality 靈修一瞥 150 (Matt 瑪 13:24-30) Fr. Abraham Chiu 趙必成神父

天主為何允許邪惡在世上如此得逞？天主為何容許惡人壯大？天主不會閉上一隻眼睛，裝作什麼都看不見；有一個時刻，叫世界末日。在末日收割時，必除去莠子。從神修角度來看，天主利用作惡者的邪惡和不正義來淨化天主子民。

在麥田裡撒莠子，是仇人對農夫的粗暴報復行為。仇人指的是魔鬼，而家主象徵天主，僕人比作義人。在收穫季節，收割者會先收集莠子，捆好，然後燒掉。耶穌說：“收割時，我要對收割的人說：你們先收集莠子，把莠子捆成捆，好燃燒，把麥子卻收入我的倉裡。”名詞“收割”（*therismou*）表示最後審判時刻，那時義人被聚集到天國，惡人卻墮落地獄去。惡人存在的正面意義，只是為了淨化義人，好讓他們為耶穌受苦成為對主的見證。

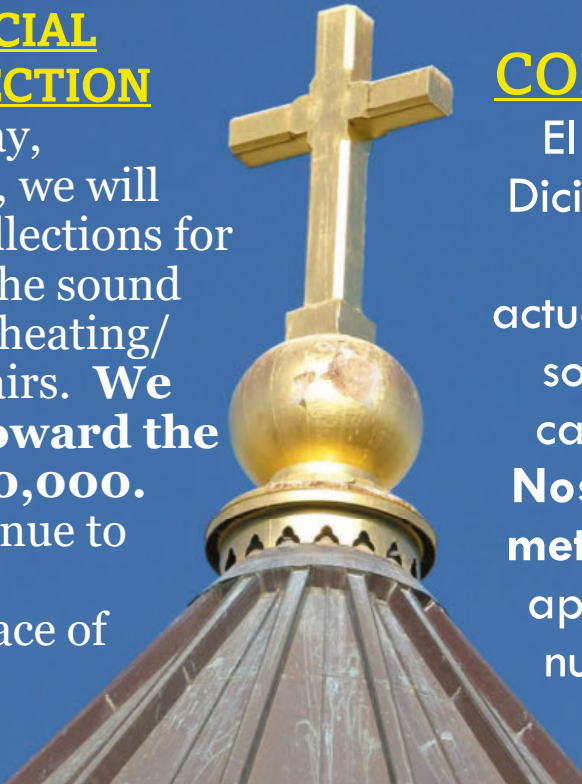
卡·拉內曾說：“無神論的首要原因是基督徒本身。無信的世界簡直不敢相信，竟然有那些嘴巴傳揚天主，生活方式卻否認天主的人。”他們是麥子中的莠子，儘管他們像基督徒一樣說話、歌頌和祈禱；但並不一定意味著他們是基督徒。

必須記住，收割時間將按照天主旨意進行，而非人的時間表。因此，與其問天主為何容許邪惡存在，不如問祂對基督徒有什麼期望。

ADVENT: Let us Make Room for Jesus Christ

This coming Sunday, December 1, we begin the Liturgical Season of Advent: a four-week period of preparation for Christmas. Each Advent is a new beginning and a new chance to allow Jesus to enter more deeply into our hearts. Jesus has so many special graces for us if we can only purify our hearts and divest ourselves of all the secular distractions, to be able to hear what He has to say to each one of us. **This preparation help us recognize the presence of Jesus in three ways:**

- we prepare our hearts to celebrate the birth of Jesus that happened over 2,000 years ago;
- we celebrate His coming in the present at Mass, in our hearts, and in each other; and
- we celebrate and prepare ourselves for His second coming in glory at an unknown future time, when we will see Him face to face.

Cada Adviento es un nuevo comienzo y una nueva oportunidad para permitir que Jesús entre más profundamente en nuestros corazones. **Focus of the Gospel:**

*Signs. We use signs to navigate life, whether we are driving down the road, searching the internet, or finding our way around a school campus or workplace. Signs tell us what is coming up so we can prepare and know what to expect. When it comes to thinking about the future, we would like to have a sign. We have no need to search for signs. Jesus said:*

**“.. they will see the Son of Man coming in a cloud with power and great glory. But when these signs begin to happen, stand erect and raise your heads because your redemption is at hand.”**

*We do not need to look—the sign will be very clear. However, we do need to prepare now for when the sign arrives. Our November FFF lessons were all about Heaven and how we can be ready when we are called home. Keep our hearts pure through loving God and loving our neighbor. The more we love, the greater our love increases, and the more joy we will experience when Jesus does come.*
