YOU MAY HAVE A SEXUAL ABUSE CLAIM OR OTHER CLAIM AGAINST THE DIOCESE OF SACRAMENTO

On April 1, 2024, The Roman Catholic Bishop of Sacramento aka Diocese of Sacramento filed a chapter 11 bankruptcy petition for protection under title 11 of the United States Code.

If you were sexually abused by any person connected with the Diocese, you must file a claim so as to be received by October 1, 2024, or otherwise you will be forever barred, estopped, and enjoined from asserting such claim against the Diocese.

Claims based on acts or omissions of the Diocese that occurred before April 1, 2024, must be filed on or before October 1, 2024, even if such claims are not now fixed, liquidated, or certain or did not mature or become fixed, liquidated, or certain before April 1, 2024.

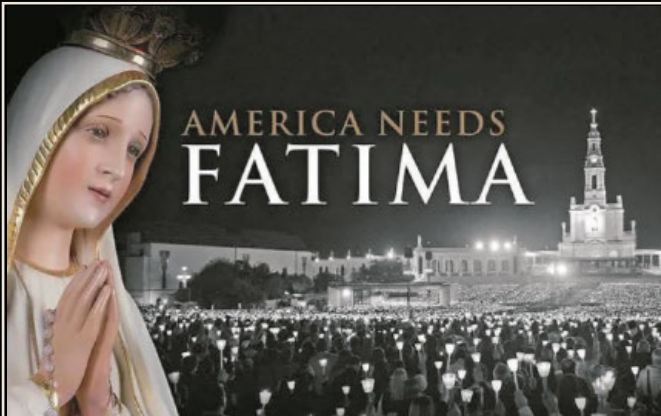

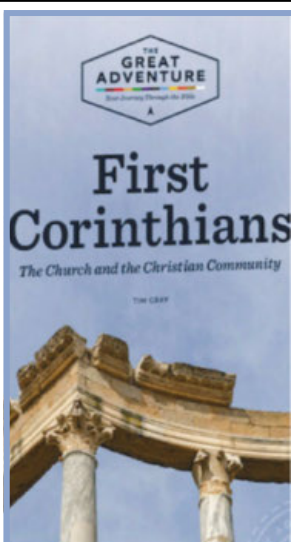

A Glimpse of Spirituality 靈修一瞥 142 (Mark 谷9:2-10)

Fr. Abraham Chiu 趙必成神父

基督徒在哪裡看見耶穌？耶穌曾說：“凡你們對我這些最小兄弟中的一個所做的，就是對我做的。”（瑪25:40）因為小人物也是基督的身體。門徒被召叫去服務弱小者，非富人。耶穌的愛沒有等級，他愛每一個人，包括迫害他的人。服務弱小象徵信仰團體的包容態度。

耶穌顯聖容主要目的之一，是讓他所揀選的門徒意識到他的神聖光榮，這樣就可以放棄世俗野心和政治默西亞的夢想，並在考驗的時刻受到鼓勵；那時，他們就成了世上最小的。因此，耶穌顯聖容將是一杯水：“誰若只給這些小子中的一個，一杯涼水喝，因他是門徒，我實在告訴你們，他決失不了他的賞報。”（瑪10:42）

祈禱時，耶穌充滿天上光榮，讓人想起梅瑟（出3:1-4）和厄裡亞（列上19:9-18），他們也經驗過天主光榮。梅瑟和厄裡亞這兩位法律和先知的代表指向耶穌，他是法律和先知的頂峰。兩位早期先知最初都被人民拒絕，但最後卻得到天主平反。

天父在雲中對門徒說：“這是我的愛子，你們要聽從他！”動詞“聽”（akouete）表示對耶穌聖言的理解並將其付諸實踐。因此，每個基督徒都會在他們的生命中展現耶穌的面容，特別在懷疑、絕望和無助的黑暗時刻，回想耶穌顯聖容將幫助我們接近天主。

通過接受每天的十字架，在苦難中更接近耶穌，最終分享他聖容的光榮。

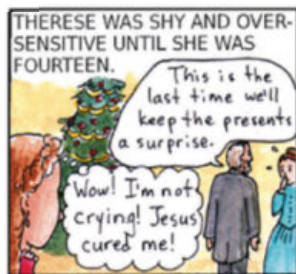
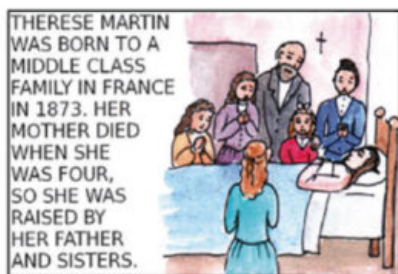

Focus of the Gospel:

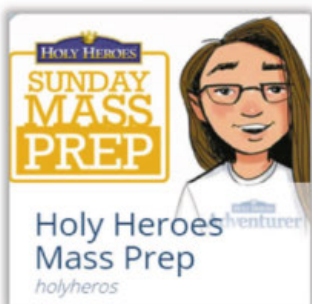
Jesus' teaching about divorce and remarriage can be a challenging one for many people. The Church continues to uphold the strong and positive teaching of Jesus that God intends for a man and woman to make a lifelong commitment to one another in the Sacrament of Marriage. Many of us, however, know people whose marriage has not been a lifelong commitment. The example of Jesus teaches us that we are called to act with compassion and love in our relationships with all, and especially when people are hurting because of difficulties in their relationships. Most importantly, we remember that when marriages thrive, it is a sign of God's grace at work.

TWENTY-SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

SEPT. 29, 2024

READING 1 NM 11:25-29

The LORD came down in the cloud and spoke to Moses. Taking some of the spirit that was on Moses, the LORD bestowed it on the seventy elders; and as the spirit came to rest on them, they prophesied.

Now two men, one named Eldad and the other Medad, were not in the gathering but had been left in the camp. They too had been on the list, but had not gone out to the tent; yet the spirit came to rest on them also, and they prophesied in the camp. So, when a young man quickly told Moses, "Eldad and Medad are prophesying in the camp," Joshua, son of Nun, who from his youth had been Moses' aide, said, "Moses, my lord, stop them." "Whoever causes one of these little ones who believe in me to sin, it would be better for him if a great millstone were put around his neck and he were thrown into the sea. If your hand causes you to sin, cut it off. It is better for you to enter into life maimed than with two hands to go into Gehenna, into the unquenchable fire. And if your foot causes you to sin, cut it off. It is better for you to enter into life crippled than with two feet to be thrown into Gehenna. And if your eye causes you to sin, pluck it out. Better for you to enter into the kingdom of God with one eye than with two eyes to be thrown into Gehenna, where 'their worm does not die, and the fire is not quenched.'"

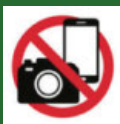

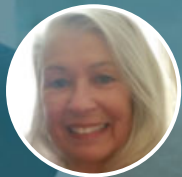

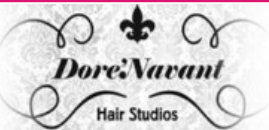
