

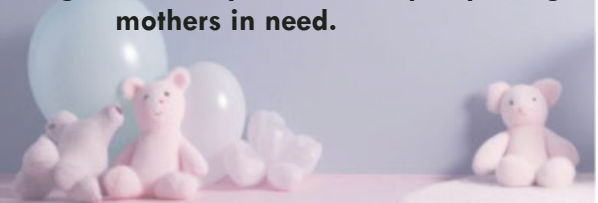

PARISH COUNCIL ELECTIONS ARE COMING UP!

Next month currently active parishioners will be invited to vote on nominees approved by the pastor to fill open positions on the Cathedral Parish Pastoral Council (PPC).

The PPC is the consultative body for the pastor. Its mission is to foster pastoral growth and parishioner engagement, encouraging time, talent, and treasure from the parish community. The group helps the pastor promote and implement stewardship initiatives and pastoral activities.

PPC members serve a two-year term and are eligible to serve two additional consecutive two-year terms. The maximum member's term is six years.

Currently there are five positions to fill on the PPC, three of which may be appointed by the pastor. The positions not filled by the pastor will be elected by the parishioners.

Final candidates will be presented to the Parish on October 20 and October 27 in the Sunday bulletin and on the Cathedral website. Voting will take place on November 10 after all the Masses. Election results will be announced in the Cathedral bulletin and website on Sunday, November 24. Elected members will serve beginning December 1.

Your participation in the voting process is important to assure that elected members of the PPC truly represent all members of our parish.

A Glimpse of Spirituality 靈修一瞥 144 (John 若6:24-35)

人們急於找到能為他們提供默西亞瑪納的奇蹟締造者，於是他們乘船到葛法翁尋找耶穌。縱然人們向耶穌提出多個膚淺問題；耶穌卻細心以天主子權柄回答他們。

問題一：“辣彼，你什麼時候到了這裡？”這簡單問題讓耶穌教導眾人尋找永生食糧的必要，就是相信天主派來的人子。

問題二：“你行什麼神蹟給我們看，好叫我們信服你呢？”耶穌被群眾要求提供超越梅瑟瑪納奇蹟的憑證；耶穌卻指向另一種來自天上的真實食糧。

第三個是請求：“主！你就把這樣的食糧常常賜給我們吧！”耶穌自我啟示為來自天上的真實食糧，他是唯一能使人認識天主並能賜予永生的。

總結耶穌啟示的三個答案，他教導人們不要為了填飽肚子的食糧而拼命，更不要為腐朽食物而工作，而是必須為了永恆食糧而活而工作。

耶穌說：“我就是生命的食糧；到我這裡來的，永遠不會飢餓；信從我的，總不會渴。”“生命”（zōēs）一詞在若望神學中解作永生。這“生命”是可以吃的，因為耶穌把它命名為“食糧”。吃一般食物並且消化之後，會增強人的健康，繼續塵世生活。然而，基督徒在吃生命之糧時，卻被耶穌的生命消化；這是耶穌自我啟示之一：“我是”。換言之，他是永生，他可以被“吃掉”。這裡的“吃”意味著將生命投入耶穌的生命中，即他所說的“信從我的，總不會渴”；因為基督徒將被耶穌吸收，進入永生。

人仍然問：“我們該做什麼，才算做天主的事業呢？”耶穌的食物就是遵行天主旨意：“我的食物就是承行派遣我者的旨意，完成他的工程。”（若4:34）實行天主工作的唯一方法，就是相信天主所派來的耶穌。

送禮者和禮物是同一個。作為來自天上的生命之糧，耶穌宣稱只有他才能滿足人的精神飢餓。通過天主賜給我們無限的愛，這生命之糧，即耶穌自己，給天人之間建立愛的關係。

基督徒先被生命之糧照亮，因此有能力以信仰照亮黑暗世界。

OCTOBER WEEK 2: THE GOSPELS

The Four Evangelists

Of all the sacred books of Scripture, the Gospels are the heart, for it is in the Gospels that the words and actions of Jesus are written down for us to read. Because Jesus is the center of this part of the Bible, it is the center of the Liturgy of the Word in Mass, and it should be the center of our study. Our lesson this week in Family Faith Formation is to get to know the authors of the four Gospels, the four evangelists: Matthew, Mark, Luke and John.

Focus of the Gospel:

The focus of the readings next week is the difficult message that suffering, willingly accepted in an attitude of service, can be a means of salvation. The servant in Isaiah gives his life for sins of others, and "his suffering will save many people." Jesus presents the same challenge. It is the servant, not the power-loving rulers, who image the life of Jesus. It is the servant, whose life is given willingly, who saves many people. Both readings present the profound mystery of salvation through suffering.

- ◆ What did Jesus say about how about how leaders among Christians should be?

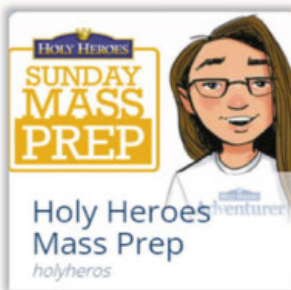

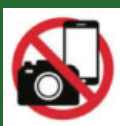

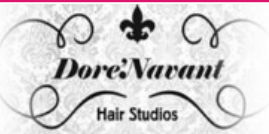
