A Glimpse of Spirituality 靈修一瞥 145 (Matt 瑪 14:1-12)

Fr. Abraham Chiu 趙必成神父

若翰犯了什麼罪？傷害過誰？是否為了叛逆統治者而說出天主真理？

若翰沒犯罪。黑落德的愧疚驅使他監禁若翰，要他閉嘴。簡言之，若翰被斬首不是因為他犯了任何罪行；而是為了維護天主正義，無論代價多大，他都甘願付出。

黑落的愧疚感尋常，良心是天主賜給人們做出道德決定的最佳禮物之一，即使他們不認識天主是誰。做了惡事之後，良心就像警報，向人發出愧疚訊號。一旦他殺死若翰，雖然外表假裝沒事，黑落德良心還是不安，特別是當他聽說耶穌在加里肋亞的牧職：“這是洗者若翰，他由死者中復活了；為此，這些奇能才在他身上運行。”

在敵對勢力面前，若翰以無可置疑的勇氣，站在天主聖言的永恆基礎上。為了伸張天主正義，若翰直接勸告黑落德：“你不可佔有這個女人！”“不可佔有”在希臘版本意是“不合法”。動詞「合法」（*exestin*）不是指民法，而是指天主法律。黑落德和黑落狄亞犯下的罪，不是民法那麼簡單，是淫亂，違反第六誡，因為黑落狄亞這女人是黑落德兄弟的妻子。若翰提醒黑落德的良心是關於天主法律的罪，但這行動卻成了他的罪。

若翰站在天主永恆真理上。眾所周知，除非站在天主真理上，人只能聽從他人意見，甚至更糟，是聽從自己不可靠的感覺來導航人生；在這路線，內疚只會讓人陷入更多罪惡，就像黑落德和黑落狄亞否認天主真理一樣。

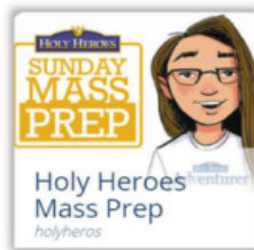

Focus of the Gospel:

Our readings continue to focus on God's loving care in real concrete ways. In the first reading, Jeremiah tells the good news of their release from exile in Babylon—a reason to praise the Lord—through God's loving intervention. Jesus, too, expresses God's mercy through the healing of the blind man, Bartimaeus. Both accounts use the image of a 'road'. Jeremiah says that God promised a straight road on which no one would stumble and fall. Mark tells us that Bartimaeus called out for pity, as he was sitting by the side of the road; he immediately follows Jesus on the road after receiving his sight (a biblical symbol for the way of salvation).

Enfoque del evangelio:

Nuestras lecturas siguen centrándose en el cuidado amoroso de Dios de manera realmente concreta. En la primera lectura, Jeremías cuenta la buena noticia de su liberación del exilio en Babilonia—un motivo para alabar al Señor—gracias a la intervención amorosa de Dios. También Jesús expresa la misericordia de Dios a través de la curación del ciego Bartimeo. Ambos relatos utilizan la imagen de un «camino». Jeremías dice que Dios prometió un camino recto en el que nadie tropezaría ni caería. Marcos nos dice que Bartimeo pidió compasión, mientras estaba sentado al borde del camino; inmediatamente sigue a Jesús por el camino después de recibir la vista (un símbolo bíblico para el camino de la salvación)

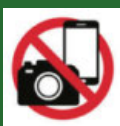

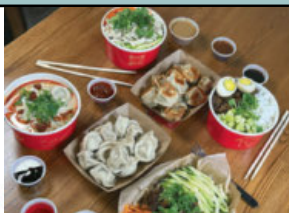
