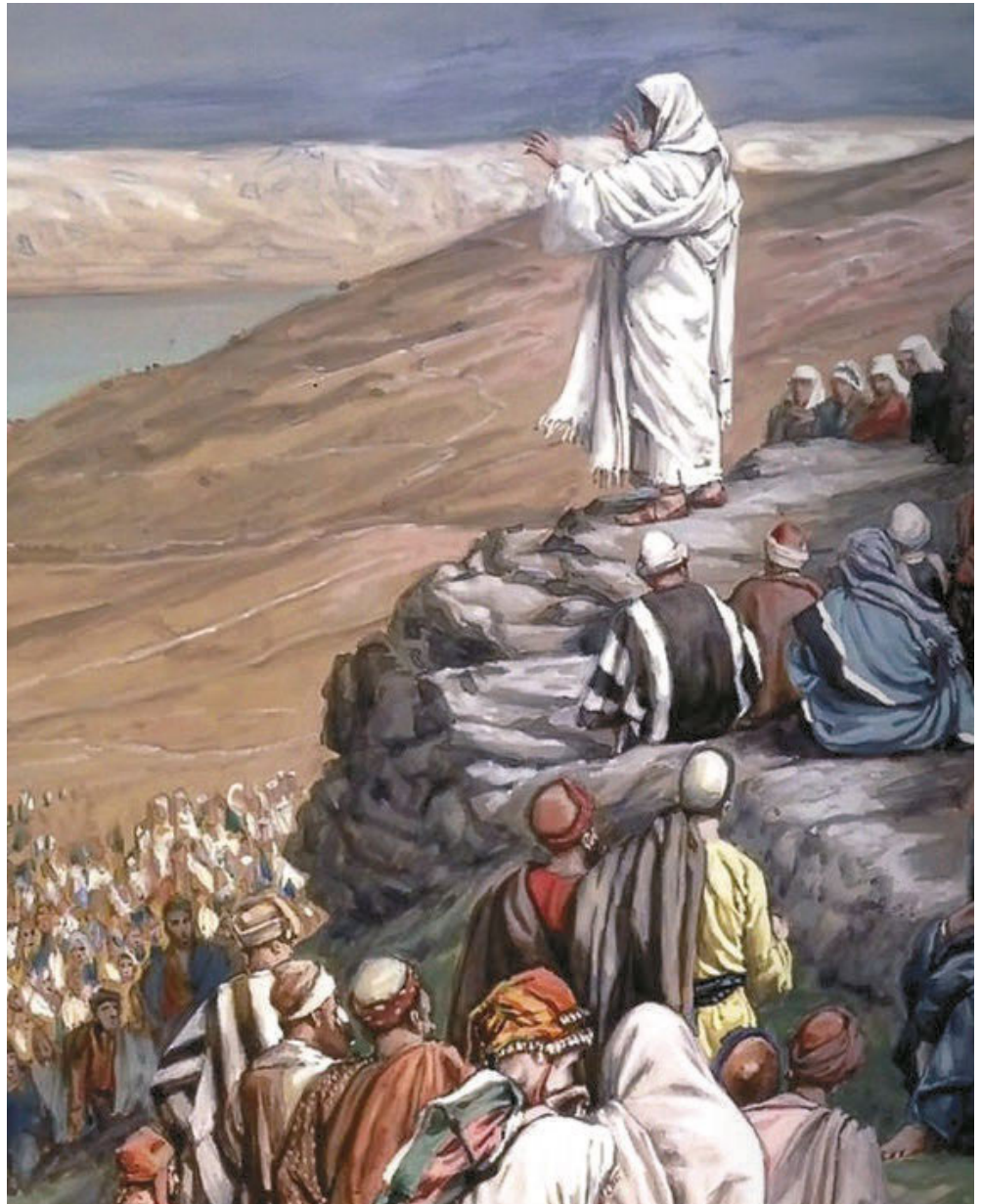

**YOU MAY HAVE A SEXUAL ABUSE CLAIM OR OTHER CLAIM
AGAINST THE DIOCESE OF SACRAMENTO**

On April 1, 2024, The Roman Catholic Bishop of Sacramento aka Diocese of Sacramento filed a chapter 11 bankruptcy petition for protection under title 11 of the United States Code.

If you were sexually abused by any person connected with the Diocese, you must file a claim so as to be received by October 1, 2024, or otherwise you will be forever barred, estopped, and enjoined from asserting such claim against the Diocese.

Claims based on acts or omissions of the Diocese that occurred before April 1, 2024, must be filed on or before October 1, 2024, even if such claims are not now fixed, liquidated, or certain or did not mature or become fixed, liquidated, or certain before April 1, 2024.

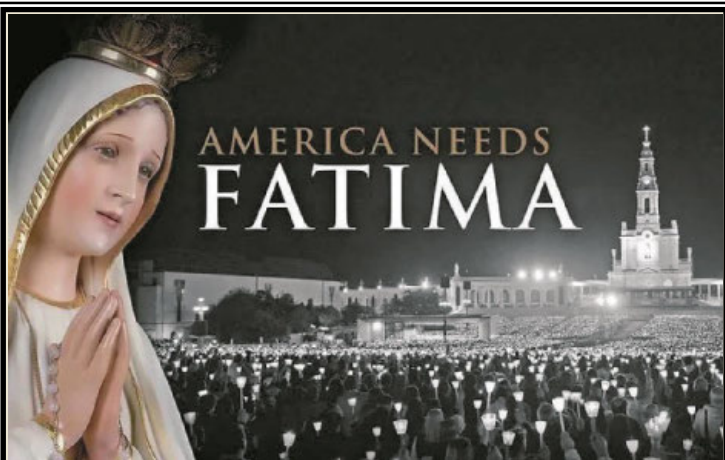

Las reclamaciones basadas en actos u omisiones de la Diócesis que ocurrieron antes del 1 de abril de 2024, deben presentarse el 1 de octubre de 2024 o antes, incluso si dichas reclamaciones no están ahora fijas, liquidadas o ciertas o no se vencieron o se volvieron fijas, liquidadas o ciertas antes del 1 de abril de 2024.

A Glimpse of Spirituality 靈修一瞥 141 (Matt 瑪 15:21-28)

Fr. Abraham Chiu 趙必成神父

客納罕婦人因著堅定信德而獲得奇蹟，證明天主不只愛那些與我們類似的人；天主慈悲延伸到那些跟我們不同的人，延伸到那些甚至是敵人的群組。當然，猶太人認為客納罕人是敵人。這就是為什麼門徒試圖趕走她，然而，信德可讓人們驚訝，奇蹟也隨之發生。

天主的視野總比人要寬大得多，教會以外的人不一定被排斥在天主大愛之外。天主的愛無邊無際，祂向所有想成為天主兒女的人伸出援手。耶穌對這婦人的回答看似非常粗魯：“拿兒女的餅扔給小狗，是不對的。”猶太文化中的“狗”(kynariois) 被描繪成負面形象；比方，在申 23:19中，猶太人將狗和賣淫等同起來：“你不可將賣淫的酬金和賣狗的代價，帶到上主你天主的殿內。。。 ”耶穌說這侮辱的話是有目的，背後目的是為了宣布這外邦女人的信德。

女人以堅定信德回答耶穌：“是啊！主，可是小狗也吃主人桌子上掉下來的碎屑。”最後，耶穌回答：“啊！婦人，你的信德真大，就如你所願望的，給你成就吧！”

我們是否願意向他人提供天主給予的慈悲？能接受那些跟我們不同的人？是否願意愛那些因被誤導而去鄙視的人？當我們聚集在祭台旁舉行彌撒時，來自各種族、各邦國的人都在聖體聖事內共融合一，我們對主的熱愛以及對聖體的渴望，都讓我們緊密相連。但願我們能像天主對我們一樣，彼此慈悲對待。

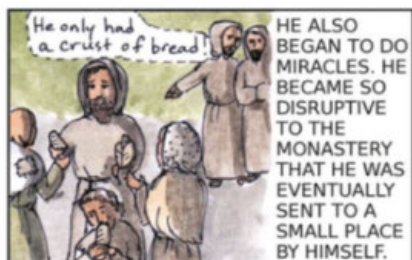
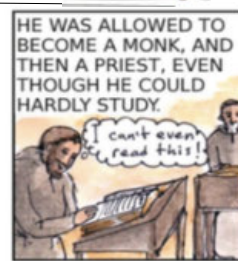

Focus of the Gospel:

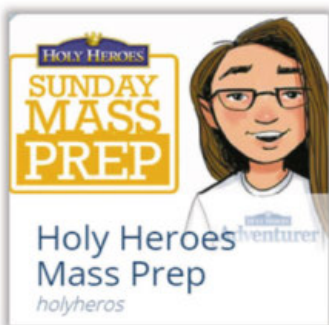
Our focus next Sunday is on the attitude we as Christians have toward one another. Christians, living by God's wisdom rather than earthly values, should treat one another with respect and love. Our first reading gives us a list of virtues—to be found among those who live by wisdom. It also describes life without those virtues—when people are jealous and think only of themselves. It leads only to fights and arguments. The Gospel passage gives us an example of this among the disciples. Jesus is quick to correct the disciples. "If you want to be among the most important ..., you must serve all other people." Our faith in Christ should make a difference in the way we treat others. Jesus presents a little child as a model for this simplicity and humility.

- ◆ Why didn't the disciples want to answer Jesus when he asked what they were talking about on the road?
- ◆ What does Jesus tell us about wanting to be important? What is a better attitude?
- ◆ Pray Psalm 54:3-8 together.

Enfoque del evangelio:

Nuestro enfoque el próximo domingo será la actitud que nosotros, como cristianos, tenemos unos hacia otros. Los cristianos, que viven según la sabiduría de Dios y no según los valores terrenales, deben tratarse unos a otros con respeto y amor. Nuestra primera lectura nos da una lista de virtudes que se encuentran entre aquellos que viven con sabiduría. También describe la vida sin esas virtudes, cuando las personas están celosas y piensan sólo en sí mismas. Sólo conduce a peleas y discusiones. El pasaje del Evangelio nos da un ejemplo de esto entre los discípulos. Jesús se apresura a corregir a los discípulos. "Si quieres estar entre los más importantes... debes servir a todas las demás personas". Nuestra fe en Cristo debería marcar la diferencia en la forma en que tratamos a los demás. Jesús presenta a un niño pequeño como modelo de esta sencillez y humildad.

SEPT. 15, 2024

READING 1 IS 50:5-9A

The Lord GOD opens my ear that I may hear; and I have not rebelled, have not turned back. I gave my back to those who beat me, my cheeks to those who plucked my beard; my face I did not shield from buffets and spitting.

The Lord GOD is my help, therefore I am not disgraced; I have set my face like flint, knowing that I shall not be put to shame. What good is it, my brothers and sisters, if someone says he has faith but does not have works? Can that

faith save him? If a brother or sister has nothing to wear and has no food for the day, and one of you says to them, "Go in peace, keep warm, and eat well," but you do not give them the necessities of the body, what good is it? So also faith of itself, if it does not have works, is dead. Indeed someone might say, "You have faith and I have works. Demonstrate your faith to me without works, and I will demonstrate my faith to you from my works.

GOSPEL MK 8:27-35

Jesus and his disciples set out for the villages of Caesarea Philippi. Along the way he asked his disciples, "Who do people say that I am?"

They said in reply, "John the Baptist, others Elijah, still others one of the prophets." And he asked them, "But who do you say that I am?" Peter said to him in reply, "You are the Christ. Then he warned them not to tell anyone about him.

He began to teach them that the Son of Man must suffer greatly and be rejected by the elders, the chief priests, and the scribes, and be killed, and rise after three days. He spoke this openly. Then Peter took him aside and began to rebuke him. At this he turned around and, looking at his disciples, rebuked Peter and said, "Get behind me, Satan. You are thinking not as God does, but as human beings do." He summoned the crowd with his disciples and said to them, "Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me. For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake and that of the gospel will save it."

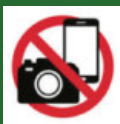

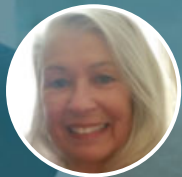
