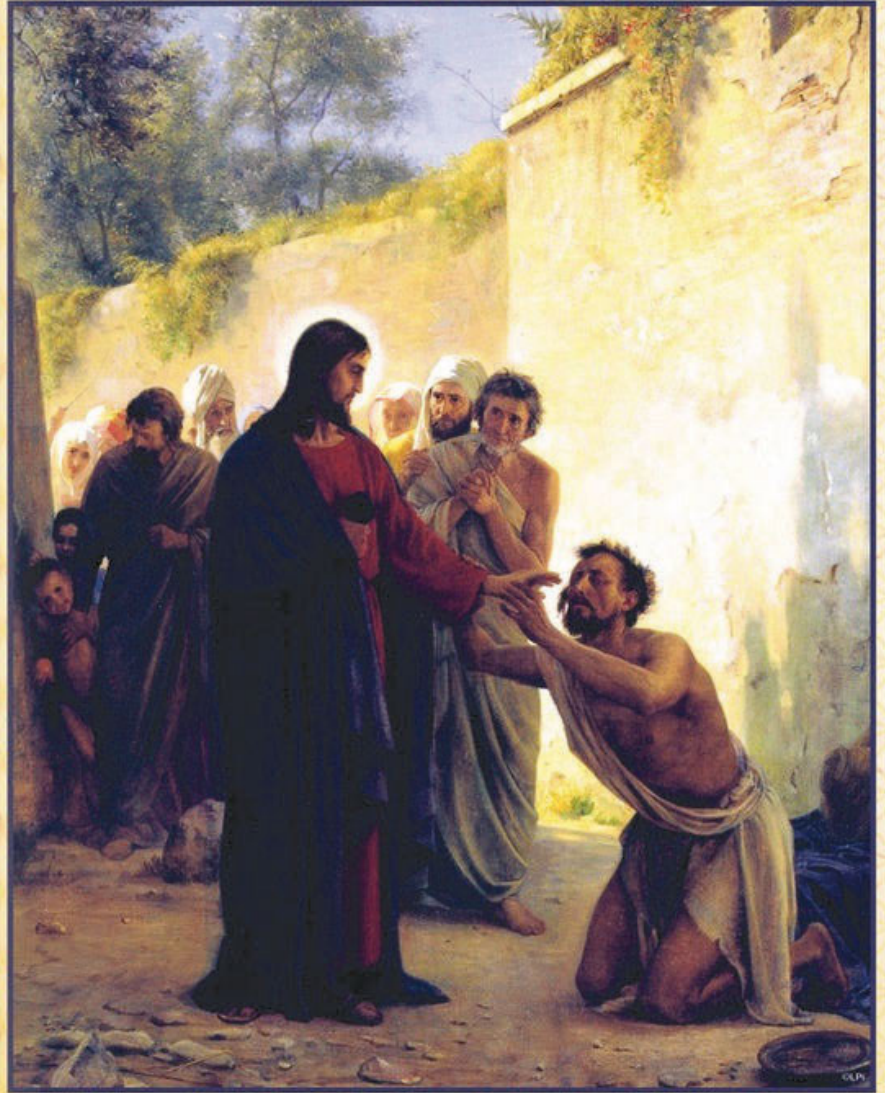



A Glimpse of Spirituality 靈修一瞥 146 R (Matt 瑪 13:47-53) Fr. Abraham Chiu 趙必成 神父

“天國”是什麼？耶穌將天國比喻為撒在海裡的網，網羅各種的魚。耶穌所說的，是拖網，網羅好魚壞魚，一視同仁。也就是說，教會是各種人聚集的團體，包括好人壞人。

比喻描繪天主愛每一個人，既愛聖潔也愛邪惡的人，只是惡人不愛天主而已。拒絕主愛，導致在最後審判之後，與主永遠分離。換言之，惡人的塵世生活讓他們與主分離，儘管天主的拖網不分好壞都把他們收集起來。

耶穌說：“天使要出去，把惡人從義人中分開。”動詞“分開”（aphoriosin）比喻那些不願跟隨耶穌的人。耶穌尊重他們的生命選擇，因為強迫信仰是沒意思的。如果這些人選擇魔鬼，那是他們個人抉擇。

讓我們永遠記住，天堂伸手可及，凡遵循生命召叫，在天主自我交付的愛之中，而非在魔鬼誘惑下，就能享受世界的平安喜樂。每當完全信靠天主，每當無私超越自私，每當自我交付的愛戰勝罪惡，信德剔除世俗憂慮，每當謙卑為人服務，我們就是按照天主旨意行事，如同在天；因此，雖然活在世界，已經住在天國。

A Beginning in the Bible

Our Faith Formation families got off to a good start this month exploring the Bible. There are **46 books** in the Old Testament, starting with the **Pentateuch** (the first five books) which teach us God's divine Law. There are also books of **History** of the People of God, **Wisdom**, and the **Prophets**. There are **27 books** in the New Testament, including the **Gospels**, the Historical book of **Acts of the Apostles**, the **Pauline & Universal Letters** and **Prophecy** book of Revelation. We will continue to work on memorization of the Books of the Bible! Check out the QR for memorization song on the next page!

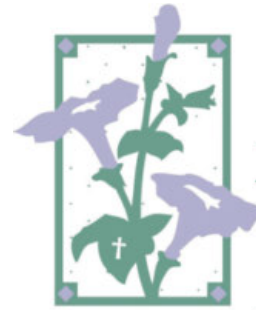

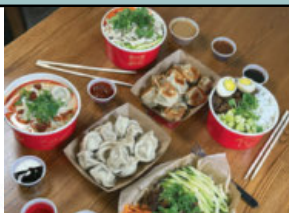
