





BIBLE STUDY 1st Corinthians

Donation envelopes for All Souls are also available in the Martyrs Chapel. Intentions for these donations are prayed over on the altar at every Mass this month.

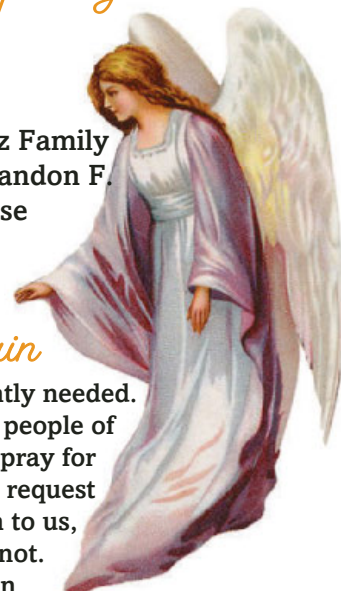

A Glimpse of Spirituality 靈修一瞥 149 (John 若6:1-15)

當我們被迫面對困難甚至災難時，怎麼做？找耶穌。這裡，耶穌面對一大群圍繞海邊徒步追趕來聽他講道的人，第一反應，是深切慈悲。餵飽群眾的神蹟，見證天主大能以及宣告耶穌的天主性；同時表明，直到今天，耶穌如何賦予門徒以他慈悲心去繼續牧靈工作的力量。

我們可以把這事件看作是天主慈悲恩賜的奇蹟，也是默西亞臨在的標記，結果是召叫基督徒去實行慈悲，特別給有需要者提供援助。身為基督徒，無論任務看來多麼不可能，在天主幫助下，都能，“因為在天主前沒有不能的事”（路1:37）。分享擘開的餅和魚，是團體共融標記，團體要提供充足食物來滿足其成員的需求，無論物質或精神。

耶穌問斐理伯：“我們從那裡買餅給這些人吃呢？”這包含目的問題表明，耶穌將以慷慨和慈悲滿足人類最基本需求—飢餓。透過增餅增魚奇蹟，耶穌向世人展示天主是慈悲的，天主關心每人需求，從物質到精神，從塵世到天國。

福音展現兩種態度：斐理伯和安德肋。斐理伯回答耶穌：“就是二百塊「德納」的餅，也不夠每人分得一小塊。”換言之，他看到的是絕望，因此什麼也做不了。然而，安德肋卻持積極生活態度：“這裡有一個兒童，他有五個大麥餅和兩條魚。”也就是說，安德肋認識到人的有限，可是相信耶穌會做事情，於是他問“但是為這麼多人，這算得什麼？”

耶穌對這五餅二魚所做的，就是“祝謝”。希臘動詞“祝謝”（*eucharistēsas*）是宴會開始或吃飯前所作的感恩祈禱。這行動確定耶穌賜予生命的權威，尤其在遇到生活困難時。這奇蹟宴席象徵天主豐富恩寵，即天主所賜永生，正如耶穌在葛法翁闡述他是生命之糧一樣。

這增餅增魚奇蹟時有發生。德蘭修女只帶了二十美仙去加爾各答的貧民窟服務。四十九年後，當她去世時，天主把最初的二十美仙變成八十所學校、三百個行動診所、七十個癲瘋病診所、三十個臨終者之家、三十個孤兒之家，以及四萬名來自世界各地的志工來幫助她。我們可以從堂區開始自己微薄貢獻，參與愛德工作。

如果我餓了，那是個人身體問題。如果我的鄰居餓了，那是神修問題。

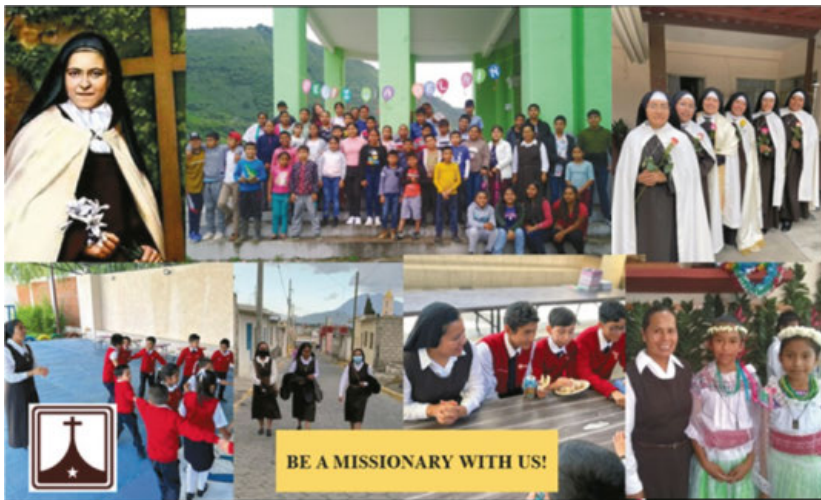

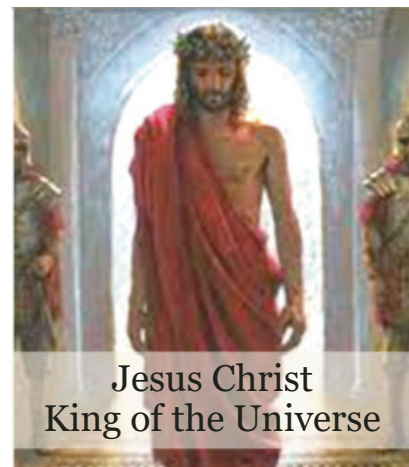

There was a 400 year silence from last OT book to the writings of the Gospels. Focus of the Gospel:

On this last Sunday of the Liturgical Year, we celebrate the Solemnity of Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. Our Gospel focus helps us consider what kind of king that Jesus is. He is standing before Pontius Pilate after a night of being brutally treated. His hands are bound with chains, his body bruised and beaten. Pilate asks, "Are you the King of the Jews?" Jesus responds that His kingdom "...does not belong to this world ... everyone who belongs to the truth listens to my voice."

In our world, we turn our attention and our ears to many famous people, often believing in their words and honoring (and even paying) to listen to them. Are they kings here to save us? What 'king' do you put above all others? Above God?

With Your Family

- ◆ Read John 18:33-347
- ◆ Imagine you are Pontius Pilate and Jesus is brought before you. You have heard that he is doing more than kings: healing the blind, feeding 10,000 with only a few fish and bread, raising from the dead. What question would you want to ask Jesus?
- ◆ It is easy to put famous people in our society as important and special, like kings and queens. Who are famous people you know? Do you talk about them more than about the Holy Trinity: Father, Son, Spirit?
- ◆ Pray Psalm 93:1-5 together.

Enfoque del evangelio:

En este último domingo del Año Litúrgico, celebramos la Solemnidad de Jesucristo, Rey del Universo. Nuestro Evangelio nos ayuda a considerar qué clase de rey es Jesús. Está ante Poncio Pilato después de una noche en la que fue tratado brutalmente. Tiene las manos atadas con cadenas, el cuerpo magullado y golpeado. Pilato le pregunta: «¿Eres tú el Rey de los judíos?». Jesús responde que su reino «...no pertenece a este mundo... todo el que pertenece a la verdad escucha mi voz».

En nuestro mundo, dirigimos nuestra atención y nuestros oídos a muchos personajes famosos, a menudo creyendo en sus palabras y honrando (e incluso pagando) por escucharlos. ¿Son reyes que vienen a salvarnos? ¿A qué «rey» pones por encima de todos los demás? ¿Por encima de Dios?

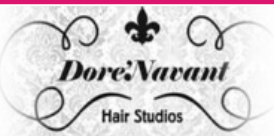

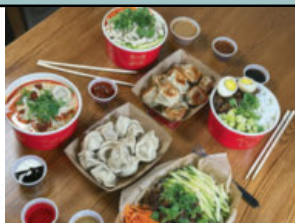
