STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION



We have all been given great power by God in the form of Time, Talents, and Treasure. Today's readings remind us that this power is meant to be used for great good. And, that failure to do so has eternal consequences.

We see the urgency for us to put our powers to good use in today's Gospel passage from Luke. Our Lord tells the rather chilling parable of the rich man who ignored poor Lazarus during their lifetimes. At the moment of the rich man's death, he goes down to the netherworld while Lazarus is taken to the eternal joy and comfort in the bosom of Abraham. The rich man keenly regrets his indifference towards the needs of Lazarus, but it is too late for regret. His choices have played out and now the rich man will face the consequences of his failure to use the gifts God gave him.

Pursuit of God's kingdom and care for the poor are not trifling matters. Our Lord makes this clear to us over and over in the Scriptures and the constant teachings of our 2,000-year old Church. We are free to ignore these teachings and live instead for ourselves. But there will be tragic results for us in the end. And, because we are made for eternity, living selfishly on this earth doesn't really bring us true happiness anyway.

So how can we use our great powers for great good? By embracing a stewardship way of life. By putting God first in all areas of our lives — in the way we spend our time, the ways we share our talents, the ways we give of our financial resources. Stewardship living calls us out of our comfort zone and into commitment to the Lord and the things that matter to Him.



In today's Gospel Jesus tells a parable about a rich man and a poor man. While they were alive, the rich man had everything he wanted. He feasted every day and was never hungry. Meanwhile Lazarus, the poor man, lay in the rich man's gate, always hungry and sick. Even the dogs came to lick the sores on his body.

Once the men died everything changed. The rich man went to Hell. He got what he deserved for thinking only of himself while he was alive. Lazarus, on the other hand, went to be with Abraham in Heaven. He had suffered so much while he was alive, but now he was perfectly happy.

The rich man wanted a drop of water to cool his tongue but Lazarus couldn't help him. He found out what happens if you only think about getting the best for yourself. What does this story make you want to do for the poor and suffering people around you?





Glimpse of Spirituality (靈修一瞥) 41

From the spiritual aspect, the devil firstly uses temptation to deal with people's desires; for instances, those who love money, give them wealth, those who love power, give them high positions, and those who love fame, let them show off to others. In other words, the devil is generous with its evil power that it will satisfy all desires the people ask for. The devil's primary purpose is to make them worship the devil and leave God.

If Christians can resist the temptation of the devil, the devil will use the second trick, i.e. torture and persecution, just as it does to Jesus. After Jesus retreated from the devil three times (Luke 4:1-13), the devil finally pushed the false religious leaders to crucify Jesus. Jesus did not jump from the cross (cf. Matt 27:40), he kept on carrying out the mission of God. To those who persecuted him, he returned them with unconditional forgiveness: "Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do." (Luke 23:34)

The devil finally defeated under Jesus' forgiveness to sinners.

When the disciples encountered the storm, they seemed to have died: "And behold, there arose a great storm on the sea, so that the boat was being swamped by the waves." However, seeing Jesus sleeping peacefully and feeling flustered, they judged and complained to Jesus, saying, "Save, Lord; we are perishing."

The noun "storm" (seismos) means shaking, commotion, or tempest. It describes the turbulent waves, which can overthrow the boat. The passive verb "swamped" (kalyptesthai) means that the waves are going to kill the disciples.

Problem: The disciples did not fully believe in Jesus's power and cried out to him that they were dying. "Perishing" (apollymetha) is destruction or death. They simply ignored Jesus' authority of life. Moreover, Jesus had his own way to deal with the storm. In addition, the disciples also forgot that even if they died because of following Jesus, they would be raised up to life eternal.

Jesus challenged his disciples: "Why are you afraid, Oh men of little faith?" The adjective "afraid" denotes being coward, timid, or fearful. The disciples had no Jesus in their hearts; hence, their faith was sunk by the storms of life.

Jesus "rose" (egertheis). This is a verb that, in addition to waking up from sleep, also means resurrection: "the dead are raised up (egeirontai)." (Matt 11:5) By allowing the storm to attack life, Jesus takes this opportunity as to reveal his grace to people, especially resurrection from the dead.

Life is full of storms. When Jesus is kept in heart, we thus sail straightly to the kingdom of God.

從神修來看,魔鬼通常先以誘惑來對付人的慾望;愛錢的,給他們富貴,愛權的,送他們高位,愛名的,就讓他們炫耀人前;換言之,他們求什麼來滿足慾望,魔鬼都慷慨奉送,目的就是要他們崇拜魔鬼,離開天主。特別是他們求天主名利錢權的時候,天主沒給,他們就離開天主,跑到魔鬼去。

如果能夠抵抗魔鬼誘惑,魔鬼就會用第二招,施以酷刑,是迫害,如同對待耶穌一樣。當耶穌三退魔鬼之後(路4:1-13),魔鬼最後推動虛假宗教領導,將耶穌釘死,以為成功毀滅耶穌與教會。耶穌沒有從十字架上跳下來(參瑪27:40),他堅持執行天主使命,對罪人的迫害,他回報以寬恕: "父啊,寬赦他們吧!因為他們不知道他們做的是什麼。"(路23:34)

魔鬼終於無計可施

門徒遇到風浪,看來喪命: "忽然海裡起了大震盪,以致那船為浪所掩蓋。"可是看到耶穌安心依枕而睡,心慌,就判斷並且抱怨耶穌說: "主!救命啊!我們要喪亡了。"

"震盪"(seismos)解作震動、騷動或暴風雨,形容破濤洶湧,巨浪掩蓋整條船; "掩蓋"(kalyptesthai)意即海浪覆蓋,接近喪命關頭。

問題:門徒沒有完全相信耶穌能力,大聲呼叫他們快死; "喪亡" (apollymetha)是毀滅或死亡,耶穌在跟前,自有他的方法處理狂風巨浪,跟著他,就算死,還是生。

因此耶穌教訓門徒說: "小信德的人啊! 你們為什麼膽怯?"

"膽怯"(deiloi)意指膽小、懦弱或害怕,門徒心中無主,才被人生風浪打沉。

耶穌"起來"(egertheis),這動詞除了是從睡夢中醒來,還有復活的含義: "死人復活(egeirontai)"(瑪11:5)。耶穌這一舉動,容許風浪打擊人生,是啟示他給人死裡復活的恩寵。

人生到處風浪, 心中有主, 直航天國
