READINGS/MASS INTENTIONS

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STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

Today's readings show us that it is not enough to be Christ's disciples in name only. To be a real disciple, we must live for Christ every day and in every aspect of life. This kind of life takes strength and discipline.



Intentionally and consistently offering the Lord the best of our Time, Talent, and Treasure through a stewardship way of life is a form of spiritual discipline. These spiritual disciplines teach us to become ever more aware of God's constant provision for us and they keep us on the narrow path towards the Kingdom of Heaven. The more we embrace this way of life, the more we can be "trained" by the Lord in the ways of true discipleship. Though difficult, these disciplines become a source of spiritual strength.

Our Lord Himself speaks of the difficult path to the Kingdom of Heaven in today's Gospel passage from Luke. He is asked, "Lord, will only a few be saved?" Jesus responds, "Strive to enter through the narrow gate, for many, I tell you, will attempt to enter but will not be strong enough." Showing up for Mass on Sunday while living as if Christ is an afterthought the rest of the week does not make us disciples. What's more, this approach to our faith is an unjust and unloving response to our good God who has given us all that we have and are.

Jesus does not want us to merely go through the motions of faith. He wants much more from us and for us. He wants to know us deeply and for us to get to know Him so that we become His holy disciples. This is not a burden; it is a privilege. But it does take discipline, the discipline of a stewardship way of life.

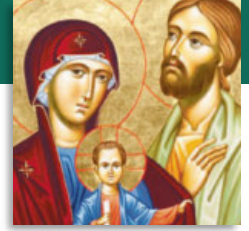

GOSPEL MEDITATION

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ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE



The serious disciple knows the necessity and value of discipline. Thinking of discipline as something punitive in nature, we underscore its place in our spiritual lives. Discipline is really about a radical trust in God and his guidance. “When you are conducted by a guide who takes you through an unknown country at night across fields where there are no tracks, by his own skill, asking no advice from anyone, giving no inkling of his plans, what choice do you have but to give yourself

completely to his guidance? If you are convinced that he is a good guide, you must have faith in him and abandon yourself to his care (Jean-Pierre de Caussade).”

If someone wants to be physically fit, they readily find a competent trainer who sets them on a rigorous schedule. Determined to reach their goals, they sacrifice personal pleasure and trust in his guidance. Why should it be any different with God? In order to remain true to the way Jesus places before us, we have to listen, learn, and be willing to change. Falling in love with God and maintaining that relationship requires an investment of time, energy, and hard work. Putting personal preferences aside in pursuit of the Gospel and giving proper attention to our spiritual lives is challenging work. At first, “all discipline seems a cause not for joy but for pain, yet later it brings the peaceful fruit of righteousness to those who are trained by it (Hebrews).”

“What God does is essentially good. It does not need to be reformed or controlled...If you would live according to the Gospels, give yourself completely and simply to the action of God (Jean-Pierre de Caussade).” Submission to the holy will of God is not a submission to a set of pre-ordained set of circumstances. Rather, it is an abandonment and trust in God’s creative, life-giving, and salvific power. God brings light out of darkness and life out of death. Nurturing this bond of trust and seeking God in all things creates an intimate and particular relationship and bond between our Creator and us. When He comes, there will be no issue with us recognizing Him or Him recognizing us. We will have met before.

ALENTAR UN ENTENDIMIENTO MÁS PROFUNDO DE LA ESCRITURA

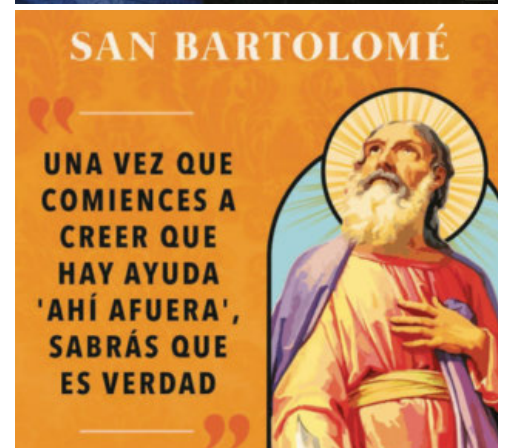
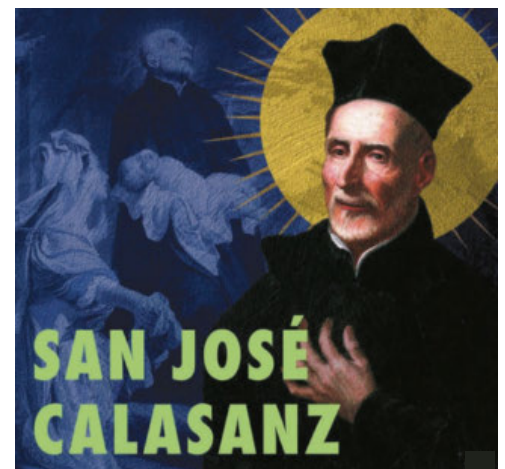
Hay palabras dichas por el propio Jesús en el Evangelio que son difíciles de comprender. Están puestas para sacudirnos de nuestro letargo. No es como recibir un mensajito lindo en el celular, ni como siempre decimos, “qué bonitas palabras dijo el sacerdote en su homilía”. No basta, inclusive, el recibir la Eucaristía el domingo que asistimos a Misa. Se necesita permanecer íntimamente con él. Jesús no responde si son pocos o muchos los que se salvan. Sino que habla de una puerta angosta: *“Esfuércense por entrar por la puerta angosta, porque yo les digo que muchos tratarán de entrar y no lo lograrán”* (Lucas 13,24). Y para ayudarnos dice: *“Pues los que ahora son los últimos, serán los primeros, y los que ahora son los primeros, serán los últimos”* (Lucas 13,30). ¿Qué te parece?

Actualmente, el Papa Francisco habla de tres puertas y creo que ilumina mucho las palabras del Evangelio de hoy. *“Orar, celebrar, imitar a Jesús: son las tres puertas que hay que abrir para encontrar el camino, para ir hacia la verdad y la vida”*. Aparentemente fácil, pero difícil de llevarse a cabo a la perfección. Cabe preguntarse lo siguiente: ¿Cómo va mi vida de oración de intimidad con Jesús? ¿Cómo celebro los Sacramentos? ¿De qué forma imito a Jesús? El Papa pide que pensemos en estas tres puertas, que nos harán mucho bien a todos. Sugerencia, abrir el Evangelio y leerlo en familia, es una forma de comenzar a entrar por la puerta angosta.

Being Punished...

In today's second reading, Saint Paul wrote to the Hebrews about being disciplined by God. When we are young God wants our parents to make sure we behave well. When we don't behave He wants them to discipline us so that we will learn to be good.



Our parents don't punish us just because they are angry at us; they do it because they really love us and want us to learn to be better. Saint Paul says that the Lord disciplines the people that He loves.



Being punished is a painful thing, but we will be happy once we have learned our lesson and become a better person. Saint Paul says, "make a straight path for your feet, so that what is lame may not be put out of joint but rather be healed." He means that

when you are punished, you should stop doing the wrong thing so that you won't be hurt worse from the punishment, but will get better instead. So the next time you are disciplined or punished, remember that God is allowing it to help you become a better person. If you can, even thank God for giving you the chance to make up for your sin and learn a good lesson!

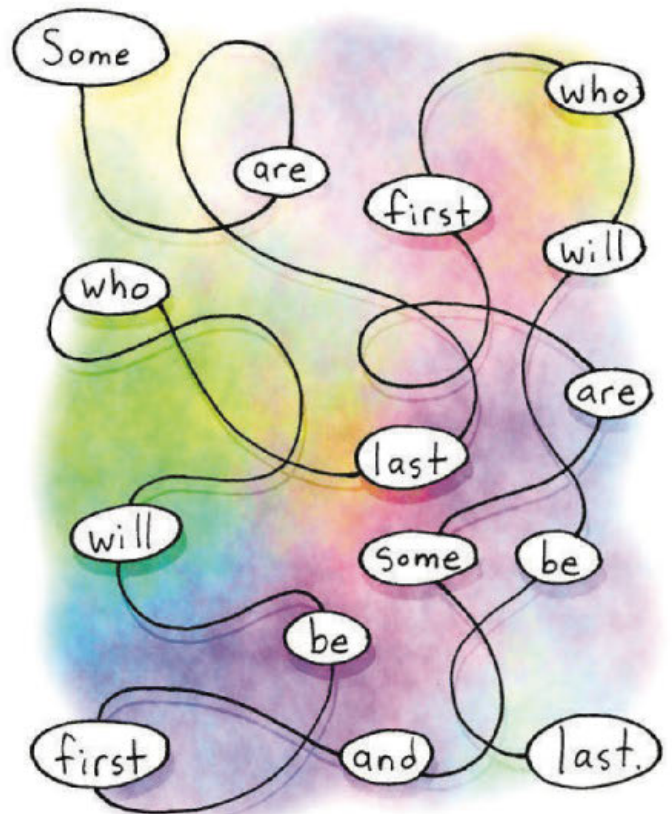

A Glimpse of Spirituality 靈修一瞥36

How can the world see God?

Not just hosting evangelization event or distributing leaflets, but above all, communion in God. If the church is divided, or even full of attack and fighting, the world will see the church as the secular world. As a result, the merciful love of Jesus will be disfigured by the divided church.

Encountering the church is like seeing Jesus: “By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another.” (John 13:35) In other words, if the disciples fight against each other, the world will know that they are fake Christians. Finally, the world does not know who Jesus is.

Jesus said, “The glory which you have given me I have given to them, that they may be one even as we are one.” The noun “glory” (doxan) is not the vanity of the world, but the love of God, which is manifested in the unity of the Father and the Son. In particular, when Jesus was crucified on the cross, this cross event revealed to the world the summit of love, i.e. forgiveness. Forgiveness is like light, illuminating the world of hatred. The glory that Jesus gives to future believers is oneness. In short, if the church is united together, it is the glory of God and also the best way to evangelize the world.

The communion in the Church, as Jesus pointed out, is the oneness with the Father and the Son: “They may be one even as we are one (kathōs hēmeis hen).”

How can the church be united in God?

Love each other, as Jesus said to the Father: “you have sent me and have loved them even as you have loved me.” It turns out that the Father’s love for Jesus is exactly the same as the love for believers. There is not any partiality. If the love of the Father has a hierarchy, then this is not eternal love but the worldly love. Here lies the nobility of humans that they are qualified to remain in the love of God and being one with the Father and the Son. “Oneness” (hen) is love. Only love can unite people from all over the world into one.

The ultimate unity is in heaven, and the testimony to God’s glory is unity in the world.

如何让世界看到天主的存在？

不只是布道大会或发传单，最重要的，是在天主内共融合一

如果教会内部分裂不和，或甚至彼此攻击批斗，世界看到教会，其实跟世俗一样，那么，耶稣的慈悲大爱，就会被分裂的教会毁容，因为，看到教会，就如同看到耶稣：“如果你们之间彼此相亲相爱，世人因此就可认出你们是我的门徒。”（若13:35）换言之，如果门徒之间彼此斗争，世人就认不出他们是基督徒，同时也不认识耶稣是谁。

耶稣说：“我将你赐给我的光荣赐给了他们，为叫他们合而为一，就如我们原为一体一样。”

“光荣”（doxan）不是世界虚荣，而是天主的爱，这爱在天父与耶稣共融合一彰显出来，特别十字架上的耶稣，他的被人钉死，正是其实爱的顶峰，是宽恕，宽恕如光，照亮仇恨人心的黑暗。

耶稣将光荣赐给未来的信徒，是合一，简言之，如果教会共融合一，这就是天主的光荣，也是福传最佳方法。

教会的共融标准，耶稣指出是跟天父与圣子的合一：“就如我们原为一体一样”。希腊版直译是“如同我们是一”（kathōs hēmeis hen, as we are one）。

教会如何在天主内合一？

彼此相爱：“并且你爱了他们，如爱了我一样。”原来天父爱耶稣的爱，与爱信徒的爱，完全一样，没有偏心。如果天父的爱有等级，那么，这非永恒不变的爱，是人间暂时的爱。人的高贵就在这里，在天主的爱里面，跟耶稣一样，跟天父合而为一。

“一”（hen）就是爱。只有爱，才能将来自五湖四海的人，团结一起。

终极合一在天国，世界的作证，在合一。
