





A Glimpse of Spirituality 靈修一瞥123 (Luke 路1:57-66) Fr. Abraham Chiu 趙必成神父

The birthday of John the Baptist tells the truth: the incarnation of the Son of God brings us salvation. However, humans are too clever to destroy God's salvation for a stupid reason: atheism. When people think that they are the lords of others, pride naturally corrupts their hearts and finally, the whole world. Atheism comes from pride, which stands against God's mercy.

When Elizabeth bore a son, God has shown his mercy to Elizabeth in concrete and loving action. God's grace released Elizabeth's shame in accordance with the Jewish culture. With the birth of John, God continued to fulfill what he promised in Luke 1:5-25, i.e., leading all people to God.

Every child brings us the future of the world, like John the Baptist. As the promise of God moved ahead, John the Baptist brought repentance to sinners before the coming of Jesus. The people said, "What then will this child be? For the hand of the Lord was with him." "The hand of the Lord" (cheir Kyriou) denotes the presence of God who protects John in every way. In other words, John will walk on the way of God under God's protection.

The crowd fully expected custom to be followed. The protest of the crowd shows that they were unaware of what God is doing. By repeating the name his wife gave, Zechariah echoed the instructions of the angel, not the crowd and custom. He went the way of God and amazed his neighbors.

With John, God has prepared the way for his promise. Sometimes, going God's way contradicts the main trend of the world, like the preaching of John. In which way we are able to be another John for this corrupted world?

洗者若翰的誕生訴說一個事實：天主子降生成人為世界帶來救恩。然而，聰明人類就因一個愚蠢理由而毀掉天主救恩，是無神。當人們認為自己是舉世無雙統治者時，驕傲自然會腐蝕他們內心，最終腐蝕整個世界。無神來自驕傲，相對天主慈悲。

當依撒伯爾生下若翰時，天主以具體而仁愛的行動向她展現慈悲；天主恩寵按照猶太文化，將依撒伯爾從人間恥辱釋放出來。隨著若翰誕生，天主繼續實現祂在路1:5-25中的應許，帶領眾人改信天主。

每個孩子誕生都為世界帶來希望，如若翰。隨著天主救贖工程向前推進，若翰在耶穌公開生活之前給罪人帶來悔改的洗禮。群眾說：“這孩子要成為什麼人物啊？因為上主的手與他同在。”“上主的手”（cheir Kyriou）表示天主在各方面保護若翰，換言之，若翰在上主保護下走上天主道路。

眾人只是遵守習俗，他們反對給孩子起名若翰，表明他們不懂天主旨意，透過重複他妻子所起的名字，匝加利亞回應天使的傳達，不跟習俗，因他走的，是上主道路。

天主已藉著若翰為他的應許預備道路。有時，走上主道路會與世界主流趨勢互相矛盾，就像若翰的宣講一樣。

怎樣才能成為腐敗世界的另一個若翰？






Come Holy Spirit! The Novena to Pentecost begins this Thursday!

Focus of the Gospel:

Throughout this Easter Season, we have been journeying with the disciples as they came to realize that Jesus really was raised from the dead. "He is Risen! As He promised! Alleluia!" The Church traditionally celebrates 40 days of Jesus' appearing to his disciples on the Thursday of the 6th week of Easter with the Solemnity of the Ascension, when Jesus gives last instructions to the disciples before ascending to heaven. He tells them, "Go into the whole world and proclaim the gospel (the good news) to every creature." The disciples witnessed Jesus going up through the clouds. Jesus promises those who follow His message that they (we) "...will drive out demons, speak new languages, pick up serpents with their hands... (heal the sick)." They were given a share in Jesus' power for the good of making Him known and loved. He calls us to believe that we can—in His name—do good.

A lo largo de este tiempo de Pascua, hemos estado viajando con los discípulos mientras se daban cuenta de que Jesús realmente había resucitado de entre los muertos. "¡Ha resucitado! Como prometió. Aleluya!" La Iglesia celebra tradicionalmente los 40 días de la aparición de Jesús a sus discípulos el jueves de la 6ª semana de Pascua con la Solemnidad de la Ascensión, cuando Jesús da las últimas instrucciones a los discípulos antes de ascender al cielo. Les dice: "Id por todo el mundo y proclamad el evangelio (la buena nueva) a toda criatura". Los discípulos fueron testigos de cómo Jesús subía por las nubes. Jesús promete a los que siguen su mensaje que ellos (nosotros) "...expulsarán demonios, hablarán nuevas lenguas, cogerán serpientes con las manos... (curarán a los enfermos)". A ellos se les dio una parte del poder de Jesús para el bien de darlo a conocer y hacerlo amar. Él nos llama a creer que podemos -en Su nombre- hacer el bien.

When Peter entered, Cornelius met him and, falling at his feet, paid him homage. Peter, however, raised him up, saying, "Get up. I myself am also a human being."

Then Peter proceeded to speak and said, "In truth, I see that God shows no partiality. Rather, in every nation whoever fears him and acts uprightly is acceptable to him."

While Peter was still speaking these things, the Holy Spirit fell upon all who were listening to the word. The circumcised believers who had accompanied Peter were astounded that the gift of the Holy Spirit should have been poured out on the Gentiles also, for they could hear them speaking in tongues and glorifying God. 




